How early should you consult a plastic surgeon before the big day? Just like with planning a wedding, the key is to start early—I would recommend nine months. We have a lot of tools in our toolbox; some are nonsurgical, some are

surgical. Try out different treatments to see how it works with your skin... it just takes all of the stress off. And there's plenty of time for a touch-up.

What are some noninvasive procedures? Something really popular to do the week before your wedding

is a Hydrafacial. That's going to give your skin a nice glow.

How soon before your wedding should you get the Golden Angle Lift? The downtime is about 10 days, but if someone's having a wedding, you probably want to schedule it at least three months in advance.
